Dear Mr. Kline:

I refer to a letter dated June 22, 2022, submitted on your behalf by Newkirk Environmental Inc., concerning the installation of a utility line utilizing jack and boring methods underneath of two named perennial streams (Burnette Creek and Pepper Creek). The proposed activity is located along Old Jesup Road, in the City of Brunswick, Brunswick County under Burnette Creek and Pepper Creek, Georgia (latitude: 31.2390, longitude: -81.5338). This project has been assigned number SAS-2022-00667, and it is important that you reference this number in all communication concerning this matter.

We understand that the proposed utility line installation would utilize jack and bore methods and that both perennial streams would not be open-cut for installation of the utility line, and that no vegetative clearing or temporary impacts to the adjacent wetlands will occur. In addition, these two perineal streams do not appear to be regulated under Section 10 of the Rivers and Harbors act in the location of the project. Based on the information provided, the proposed activities would not constitute a discharge of fill subject to the regulatory jurisdiction of the US Army Corps of Engineers (USACE), as depicted within the submitted drawings, entitled, "Brunswick-Glynn JWSC, North Mainland Water Loops Project, Area 2 Proposed Improvements" Drawing C-6 and C-9, dated July 2022. Further, no fill material will be placed below the ordinary highwater mark of the streams or in any other aquatic resources.

Consequently, I have determined that no Department of the Army Permit would be required under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act for the proposed project. In the event changes to this project are contemplated, I recommend that you coordinate with us prior to proceeding with the work. Revisions to your proposal may invalidate this determination.

not obviate the requirement to obtain state or local assent required by law for the activity described herein. If this information you have submitted, and on which the USACE has based its determination is later found to be in error, this decision may be revoked.
